SESSION 1: JESUS IS HOLY

 Today's point: Jesus is holy and that changes everything.

BECAUSE GOD IS HOLY, OUR LIVES ARE FOREVER CHANGED.

• DEFINE HOLINESS-A biblical term generally meaning "to be set apart." The term is used widely in Scripture to refer to a variety of people and objects alike but ultimately points to God as the one who is qualitatively different or set apart from creation.

PETER

- Meet Peter, a fisherman by trade who probably had very clear expectations of his path and direction in life.
- One day he had been fishing all night and was washing his nets near the shore where Jesus was teaching crowds of people. Jesus got in the boat and continued teaching (LUKE 5:1-3)

1. JESUS' WORD IS SUPERIOR TO OUR EXPERIENCE AND WISDOM (LUKE 5:4-6)

2.JESUS' WORD REVEALS OUR OWN DEPRAVITY (SINFULNESS) (LUKE 5:6-10)

AFTER NEEDING OTHER FISHERMEN TO HELP BECAUSE THHE NETS WERE ABOUT TO BREAK WITH THE ENORMOUS AMOUNT OF FISH, PETER RESPONDS RECOGNIZING HIS OWN UNWORTHINESS.

PETER SANK TO HIS KNEES IN REPENTANCE AND WORSHIP, RECOGNIZING THAT THIS MIRACLE OF FISH WAS SOMETHING ONLY SOMEONE WITH GOD'S POWER COULD DO.
